Are you a student, early career researcher or early career engineer^{*1} working in Automotive, Motorsport, Off-Road, E-Mobility or other transport related areas.



This year we are offering a large number of heavily discounted tickets for students and recent graduates, alongside a competition for free tickets.

40 tickets discounted by 50% are available to anyone in the above categories who submits an application by the end of **November 2024**. These will be awarded by lottery.*²

10 free tickets will be given to the winner of the competition, and are available to anyone in the above categories who submits a short 1-page essay by the end of November 2024 on their vision for what propulsion technologies will be like in 2050. These will be judged by the Scientific Advisory Board (the members of which are listed on the conference website).

Unsuccessful competition entrants will automatically be included in the lottery for the 50% discount.

We are also keen to give students, researchers or early career engineers the opportunity to present, and therefore welcome short abstracts for '3-minute pitch' style presentations.

We are also happy to support educators, course coordinators, or team leaders from industry, who might want to bring a cohort to the conference.
